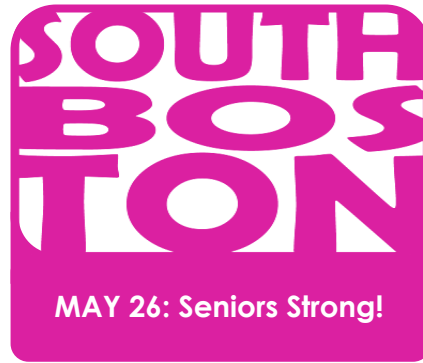
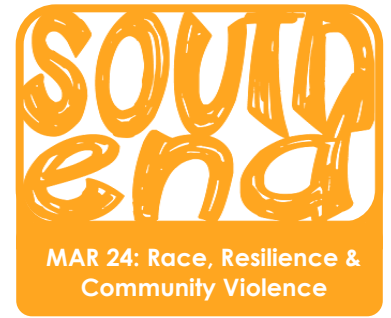


PASSPORT TO PUBLIC HEALTH
