- The group voted to amend the by-law

• Tamika gave an update on the initiative and recapped the kick-off event, which was well attended by HCC's, BACH members and community residents. She also discussed the end of the fiscal year and sustaining engagement of HCC's after the summer training.

Racial Justice Committee

- David and Jamiah distributed drafts of the scholarship and technical assistance guidelines. There was discussion around the annual budget and allocation of funds
- Damon mentioned allocating a percentage of the money to residents and cbo's, as well as setting a target number of residents to engage
- Tamika suggested raising the stipend amount, which after some debate, the group agreed to do this (half day, \$25 to \$35/full day, \$50 to \$70).
- Since this is the first time we are doing this, the group stressed the important of measuring our outreach and participation. Jamiah encouraged that the final draft be distributed to all our networks.
